SECTION I: General Plan Information

The following provides an explanation of how you may direct investments in the Plan and outlines the restrictions and policies that apply to the investment options available under your Plan:

How to provide your investment instructions

You can direct your Plan investments using any of the following:

- Enrollment form (for initial investment selection)
- Participant website at www.sheakley.com/401k

You may direct the investment of the funds held in your plan account to any of the investment options outlined in the comparative chart.

Timelines regarding your investment instructions

Investment Instructions:

- Can be given using the options outlined above
- Can be given at any time
- Are generally processed on the same business day (with the exception of special days when the Stock Market closes early or is not open), provided they are received before 4 p.m. EST (or before the New York Stock Exchange closes). If received on or after 4 p.m. EST, they will be processed the next business day.

Redemption fees

An underlying mutual fund of a Sub-account may apply a redemption fee or other fee for certain investment transfers.

Designated Investment Alternatives

Your Plan provides designated investment alternatives into which you can direct the investment of your account balance.

Voting, Tender and Similar Rights

Generally, any voting, tender or similar rights regarding the investment options available through your Plan will be exercised by your Plan Sponsor, or your Plan Sponsor's designee. Certain exceptions may apply; if your Plan Sponsor, or its designee, receives materials relating to the exercise of voting, tender or similar rights that are passed through to you, the Plan presently intends to provide them to you. You will generally have the ability to exercise voting, tender or similar

rights, regarding any investments in a self-directed brokerage account. If your plan offers Company Stock, you have the right to exercise any voting, tender or similar rights on company common stock credited to your Plan account. If applicable, you will receive proxy, tender or exchange materials along with further instructions, which you must follow in order to exercise any voting, tender or similar rights.

Self Directed Brokerage Options

The Plan does not currently include a self-directed brokerage account option.

Designated investment manager

There is no designated investment manager for this plan.

SECTION II: Administrative Expenses

The Plan pays certain outside service providers for Plan administrative services, such as legal, trustee/custodial accounting and recordkeeping services. The funds for the payment of such service expenses may be deducted from individual Plan accounts, unless the Plan Sponsor elects, at its own discretion, to pay for some or all of the Plan's administrative service expenses through non-Plan assets. The cost for these expenses may vary from year to year and is based on a variety of factors.

As of the date of these materials, the Plan administrative fees and expenses listed below may be deducted from Plan accounts as applicable. Your quarterly account statement will show any administrative fees charged to your account. To the extent that any other applicable Plan administrative expenses are not charged against forfeitures, paid by the employer, or reimbursed by a third party, the Plan may charge such expenses on a pro rata (i.e., based on the relative size of each participant account), or per capita basis (i.e., a flat fee assessed against each individual account). For example, if the Plan pays \$1000 in expenses and your account balance constitutes 5% of all of the account balances of all participants, your account would be charged \$50 (\$1000 x 5%) of the expense.

SECTION III: Individual Expenses

Your Plan imposes additional charges if you elect to use certain services/features. These charges are imposed specifically against your account, and are not imposed on a plan-wide basis.

The fees listed below apply if you use any of the services or features below:
